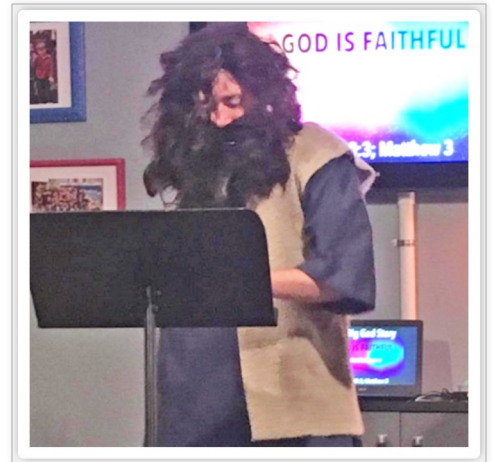


MEET TOMMY LANGEJANS
